**Reflection**

The Jews have arrested Jesus and have presented him before their leaders, who one by one have passed him on to a yet higher leader, and he ends up before Pilate. This meeting then develops into a kind of discussion between Pilate and Jesus, as to whether Jesus is the "King of the Jews" or not. Jesus replies by questioning Pilate, "Are you saying this because you have discovered this yourself, or because other people have told you that I am?" Pilate replies "Am I a Jew, your own people handed you over to me. What have you done?" Jesus replies, "My Kingdom is not of this world, if it were my supporters would have put up a struggle to prevent me being handed over to the Jews". The plain fact is my Kingdom is not of this world. So, is Jesus a King?
