Reflection

I vividly recall a visit to churches in Nigeria over 20 years ago and seeing a church in a very rural area which was literally just some benches under the shade of a tree. No doors or windows or walls. I asked what happens when the rains come and was told, "we bring our umbrellas". In that church was a simplicity and joy in Christian faith and while they had plans to build a church building, I'm sure they'd get on just fine without it as indeed they already were.

In our gospel reading today, one of the disciples looks up at the vast Temple in Jerusalem and exclaims what a marvel it is. Jesus points out that is will not last. Humans build and place one stone on top of another but on this earth nothing lasts forever. I love our church buildings and know we all do but it is worth remembering how turbulent but temporal are the things of earth. In the lifetime of the disciples the Temple would fall! Thus, the words of Jesus were prophetic to that time but still today remind us to fix our hopes on things eternal.
